Serving Ukrainian refugees in Poland



Shortly after the outbreak of the war in Ukraine, many Ukrainians fled to Poland. Donna, who served in Poland alongside a church, could see the urgent need of accommodating those affected by war. After praying with the OM team in Poland, Donna decided to open the church, providing refugees with a temporary shelter.

“People in Poland are enthusiastic to help Ukrainians. Some people donated groceries. Some let refugees stay in their homes. Some volunteered to serve at the Ukraine-Poland border where refugees came during the early stage of war,” Donna said.

For many Ukrainians, leaving their homeland is a difficult decision, but they feel they have to bring their children to a safe place. As the war persists, some Ukrainians are still waiting for the right time to go back home. It is estimated that there are 1.3 million Ukrainian refugees in Poland now. OM has established a Refugee Ministry Hub in Warsaw to offer long term assistance.

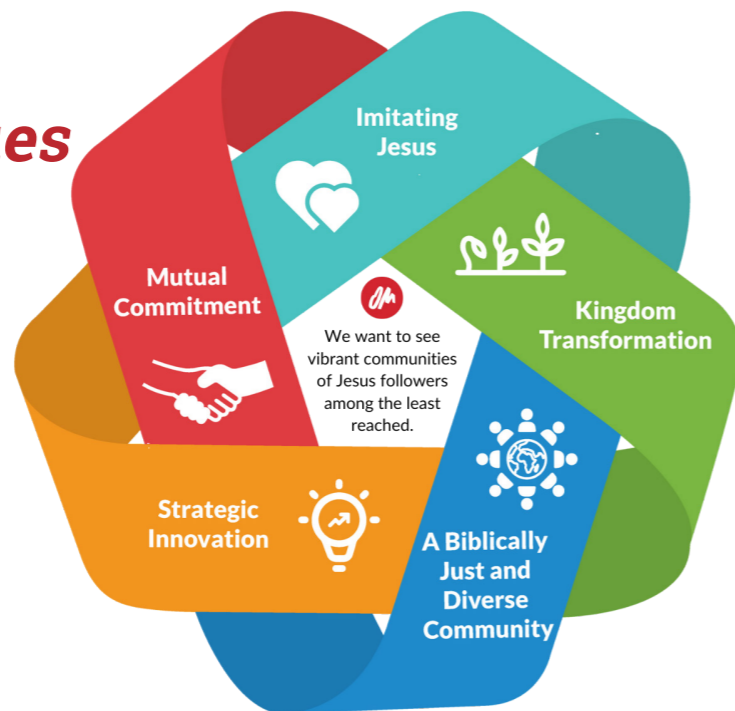
